#### **GENERAL FESTIVAL INFO**

Festival Office, located on the second floor of Pettigrew Hall, is open 8:30am-Noon & 1pm-4:30pm weekdays and 10-1 pm Saturdays. Allie Bell is the Admissions Director / Operations Manager In the office you can buy performance tickets, pick-up your mail, sign-up for rehearsal space, shop in our store, get tourist information, visit the lost and found, and get help with Festival related questions!

**Staying Informed** Important daily updates are posted at the entrance to Commons. Other festival info (bodywork & workshop sign ups) is posted outside the Festival office.

ID/Access Card & Keys are in this packet. Please save your key envelope to return access card & key in. The access card serves as your ID and opens the outside doors to your house and other buildings. Place card in front of electronic box located by the entrance. If you are living on campus the card gives you access to the dining common and athletic facilities. Your key opens vour door. Upon departure, please place card & key in key envelope and drop it in the key box just inside the front door of your house. If you lose you key or ID card or key notify the office immediately.

## The College requires us to charge a \$80 loss fee per key. DO NOT LOSE YOUR KEYS!

**Security** The Festival does not responsibility assume for personal property. Please keep your room door locked when you are out. Keep building entrance doors closed at all times. Do not excessive carrv cash valuables around campus. Keep bicycles locked. The Security Office, located at 245 College Street, is open and staffed 24 hours a day. Yellow security phones are located throughout campus and are identified with a blue liaht.

Meals are served in the Dining Common as follows: Breakfast 7-9:30am Lunch M-F 10:30am-2pm Dinner 5-7:30pm In order to be admitted to the Dining Common you must show your ID card or if you are a day student or guest, you must pay at the door. Meal prices are: Breakfast \$7.50, Lunch \$8.50, Brunch & Dinner \$9.50.

**Linens** will be replaced each Thursday <u>only</u> if you leave your dirty ones outside your door.

Laundry/Kitchens Each house has laundry facilities. To use them you must purchase a MAC card for \$5 (\$1.25 per load). MAC machine are located in the basement of Chase Hall and Pettengill 1<sup>st</sup> floor. This card can also be used in the library for photocopying. Kitchenettes are available in most residences but are not equipped.

**Bathrooms** are cleaned daily, other public spaces on Mon & Thurs.

**Alcohol** The drinking age in Maine is 21 yrs. Guests of the College must abide by the state laws while on the Bates campus. There will be no open containers on the campus without explicit permission of the administration.

**Smoking** is prohibited within 50 ft. of all campus buildings.

Fire Safety Firecrackers, flares and explosives are forbidden on campus. The use of candles or open flames is not permitted. No alteration or interference with the full effectiveness of the sprinkling systems, smoke detectors and fire alarms is permitted. Please take note of the location of fire extinguishers and fire exits in your residence.

Festival Store The store is located in the Festival Office. Here you can purchase Festival tshirts, sweat pants, kneepads, elastikon, water bottles, lanyards, books and CDs by our musicians. Store Hours are 1-2pm weekdays and 10-12 Saturdays.

Mail Correspondence may be sent c/o Bates Dance Festival, 305 College St. Lewiston, Me 04240. Mail comes in weekdays after lunch. When you receive mail it will be in the faculty mailbox in Laura's office. Package and letters may be mailed from Post and Print office on the first floor of Kalperis Hall (786-6098). Mail received after

your departure from the campus will be returned to sender.

Computer Access Wifi is available in all dorms and houses and in Ladd Library and Pettengill Atrium. To get online connect to the "Bates Open" wireless network. Accounts requires re-registration once every 48 hours. Computer kiosks can also be found in Commons.

Parking Festival participants may park in student and guest parking spaces only. Overnight parking is not permitted on Bardwell St. or in the parking lot next to Moody Hall. Please do not park in any campus driveways or in specially designated areas, such as faculty/staff, loading areas, service vehicle spaces, or handicapped accessible spaces. Cars parked in fire lanes will be subject to towing.

Health Services If you require medical attention for an acute issue please notify the Festival office (a) 207-786-6381 immediately. We will get you to the nearest treatment facility as quickly as possible. We have Concentra Urgent Care that offers walk-in urgent care at 59 East Ave (214) 630-2331). Central Maine Medical Center and St. Mary's Hospital are also very nearby. Be sure to take your insurance card with you. There is a health care referral list in the office.

Bodywork There will be three licensed practioners available for sessions on a sign-up basis. Signup sheet are on the Bulletin Board outside the Festival Office. The massage rate is \$65 an hour, Oesteopathy is more. Treatment rooms are located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Clason House on Campus Ave. Cancellations must be made at least 24 hours in

advance or payment is required.

Changing Classes Class changes may be made through 6pm on Tuesday, July 18 on a space available basis. No course changes may be made after this time. No refunds will be issued for courses dropped. To add, drop, or change a course you must see Meredith in the office. The faculty cannot authorize changes.

Attendance/Credit Be sure your presence is recorded at the start of each class. In order to provide with a Bates College transcript we must have an record accurate of your attendance. If you miss more than 3 classes you will not receive credit for the course. A copy of your transcript must be requested in writing from Allie Bell. BDF Admission Director.

#### **New Works Student Concert**

An informal adjudicated concert student works will be presented in Schaeffer Theatre on Saturday August 5th from 1-5pm. The public is invited free of charge. The program is limited to works (one choreographer) that have been created at the festival and are no longer than 6 minutes in length. Works are chosen from a drawing. Please submit your entry in the office by Tues, July 18 at Noon. If you are selected please bring your program notes to the office no later than Tues Aug 1. Lighting and tech will be minimal. We will break after every five pieces for faculty feedback.

Rehearsal Limited Space rehearsal space is available on a first-serve first-come, basis beginning Weds. July 19 at 1pm. You may sign up for space with Kristin in the office one week at a time. If you find that you need to cancel your time, PLEASE inform Kristin or erase it from the sheet posted on the office door each evening. Space is a precious commodity at the Festival!

Concert Tickets If you are a fulltime student your concert tickets are in your packet. If you are a part-time student (taking three or fewer classes) be sure to purchase your tickets (\$12) at the office in advance as we expect to sell out most shows.

Weekend Trips On Sunday, July 30 at 11:30am a bus will take students to Portland (\$20 non-refundable). Buses depart from Central Ave outside the Dining Common. Sign up in the office by Weds of trip week.

### L.L. Bean and the Freeport Shopping District:

Distance: 26 Miles, Driving Time: 30 Minutes. Great shopping (LL Bean, Banana, Republic, Gap, etc) and eateries.
